The shopping center wanted to make access more fluid, while preserving the existing structure.

The Saint-Just-en-Chaussée shopping center, which covers an area of 6,500 sq.m. and welcomes almost 2,500 customers a day, was initially equipped with two revolving doors that were unsuitable for carts and often prone to breakdowns. To improve access, the Director chose to replace these installations with custommade round automatic SAS doors, with four fixed leaves and two moving leaves to fluidify passage.

To ensure the longevity and reliability of the new doors, Portalp proposed a regional maintenance contract, available 24/7, including a fiveyear extended warranty. This offer completes the service Portalp provides its customers throughout their projects.
